Mar Ivanios College, Trivandrum Annual Report on the SSP 2015-16

Mar Ivanios College has been conducting the Scholar Support Programme since 2013-14. This is the third year of conducting of the Programme. As in the previous years, it was conducted effectively. The Programme was quite beneficial to the student-community. Students were greatly encouraged by this programme as it helped them a lot in their studies.

Participants

The total number of students enrolled this year under this Programme was 150. Out of 150 students, 50 students were from first year classes, 50 from second year and 50 from third year classes. A lot of students had applied this year for the Programme. The applications were scrutinized and the deserving students were identified and selected on the basis of their (poor) performance and (low) marks in their previous examinations. The classes for Semester-1, Semester-3 and Semester-5 were over by December 2015. The classes for Semester-2, Semester-4 and Semester-6 were over by March 2016. Most of the students were regular in classes, but few skipped with no reason. The attendance has been marked in each session. The average attendance percentage is around eighty.

First Year (Semester-1 and Semester-2)

The first year (Semester-1 and Semester-2) classes under the Programme have been taken by five Departments of the College, namely, English, Mathematics, Commerce, Zoology and Botany. Ms.Resmy Sally Koshy of English Department has taken General English classes for ten students of Semester-1 and 2. Dr. A. Venkideswaran of Mathematics Department took classes on Statistics (Complementary course for Mathematics S1) for a group of 10 students of Semester-1 and Ms. Anusha Edwin took classes on Statistics (Complementary course for Mathematics S2) for the same group of students of Semester-2. Mr. Sabu E G of Commerce Department took classes for the paper Methodology & perspectives of Business Education (Core Course for Commerce S1 and S2). Dr. Dhaniya M. V of Zoology Department took classes for the paper Animal Diversity-I and II (Core Course for Zoology S1and S2).Ms. Susan Kurian of Zoology Department took classes on Animal Diversity for Botany students (complementary course for Botany S1 and S2).

Second Year (Semester-3 and Semester-4)

The second year (Semester-3 and Semester-4) SSP classes were conducted by the five departments namely Commerce, Botany, English, Economics and Zoology. Mr. Sabu E G of Commerce department took classes for core Course for Commerce S3and S4). Dr.Bindu Alex of Botany Department engaged the classes for second year students for the paper Angiosperm Anatomy & Reproductive Botany (core course for Botany). Ms.Anusha Edwin of Mathematics Department took classes on Mathematics (complementary course for Economics S3and S4) for a group of 10 Economics students under this Programme. Ms. Divya Johnson of English Department has taken General English classes for ten students of Semester-3 and Semester-4. Ms.Lija L Raju of Zoology Department took classes for the paper Methodology and perspectives of Science (Complementary course for Zoology S3and S4).

Third Year (Semester-5 and Semester-6)

The third year (Semester-5 and Semester-6) SSP classes were conducted by the five departments namely Commerce, Botany, Botany &Biotechnology, Mathematics and Zoology.

Dr. Rejitha L R of Botany Department took classes for the paper Microbiology, Phycology, Mycology, Lichenology & Plant Pathology (Core Course for Botany S5and S6). Mr. Sabu E G, of Commerce department engaged the classes for third year students for the paper Taxation Law & Accounting. Ms. Anusha Edwin of Mathematics Research Department took classes on Statistics (Complementary course for Mathematics) for a group of 10 Mathematics students under this Programme. Dr. Siddharth Banerjee of Botany & Biotechnology department took classes on Animal Biotechnology (core Course for Botany & Biotechnology S5and S6) for weak students. Ms. Lija L Raju of Zoology Department took classes on the paper Cell Biology & Molecular Biology (core Course for Zoology S5and S6).
